the next few years. Since then she has had 4 owners and has spent time on both the Norfolk Broads and the Thames. Mahogany built cabin with opening windows and clerestory allowing full standing height. Fully upholstered cabin and dining area with matching cushions, blinds and curtains. Summer covers – full length scalloped canopy with removable windows, separate bow and stern protectors.
